



Meeting Safely in Williamson County

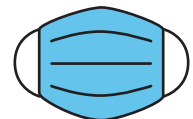

- If you have recently had or are showing COVID-19 symptoms, you must stay home.

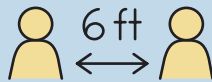

Signage is in place to assist social distancing.

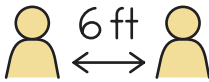


Hotels have increased scheduling cleaning of public spaces, alterations to their amenities and services such as additional hand sanitizing stations.

Room Sets will respect all social distancing guidelines.

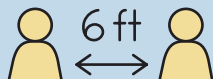


Food & Beverage:
